ATTENTION EXHIBITORS!!! FAIRGROUND RULES

NO STALLS are to be taken **APART**. Inspections will be made during the show. If any **STALL** is **DISMANTLED**, the **SHOW** will be **CHARGED** \$150.00 per occurrence.

All shavings bags **MUST** be tied into bundles & placed in or by trash cans! All bedding material must be a **WOOD BY-PRODUCT**.

Any stall with manure in it is a **HORSE STALL** and the **SHOW** will be **CHARGED** accordingly. Any stall with as little as twine or paper left in it will be charged \$50 extra for clean-up.

Camping will be allowed in designated areas **ONLY**.

Tampering with electrical equipment or unauthorized connections shall be fined \$500 per occurrence. Violators will be asked to leave!

Lunging is NOT allowed in the show arena, Fairground rule!

DOG RULE!!!!

Dogs, or other pets, are not permitted to be loose at anytime (arrival to departure) on competition grounds. Dogs, or other pets, must be kept contained or on a leash no greater than 6 feet in length under the immediate control of a responsible person and shall not be allowed to disturb or annoy visitors. The Ingham County Animal Control Ordinance and State Dog Law shall be strictly enforced. A \$50 fine will be charged for any dog **SEEN** loose on the show grounds. The person that owns or is in immediate charge of any dog shall immediately remove all droppings and deposit in trash receptacle on Fairgrounds. If no receptacle is available, droppings are to be taken off Fairgrounds and disposed. Dog, or other pet, owners failing to comply will be subject to penalty.

MJMHA and the Ingham County Fairgrounds will not be responsible for accidents or losses on the grounds. **All stalls have doors. Show Arena (size 220' x 110') & Make-up Arena footing is clay, sand, & wood shavings combined.**

REFUNDS - Exhibitors canceling entries in writing prior to closing date of entries shall be entitled to have entry fees returned. Any request to withdraw horses after closing date (April 14, 2010) of entries and prior to arrival on grounds must be supported by a Veterinarian Certificate giving comprehensive diagnosis, dated within 48 hours following the exam. **Any cancellation will result in a \$20.00 office charge.**

MORGAN DIVISION

(USEF Chapter MO)

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. Specifically Chapter MO, Morgan Horse Division.

Horses shown in this division must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association, Inc., or the Canadian Morgan Horse Association, or the British Morgan Horse Society and must be entered under their full registered names or if under one year of age be eligible for registration.

Canadian horses born before January 1, 1985 must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association, Inc., or have Canadian Morgan Horse Club registration papers showing as American registration number. Canadian horses born after January 1, 1985 can be shown with Canadian Registration papers as long as the papers do not state “not eligible for U.S. reciprocity”.

Stallions are prohibited in Ladies and Junior Exhibitor classes.

One attendant without whip must head each horse in the Park Harness and Pleasure Driving classes.

Cross entering is allowed between Classic Pleasure and all other English Pleasure and Pleasure Driving provided requirements are met with USEF.

SADDLEBRED HORSE DIVISION

SUBCHAPTER SB-1 GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS.

SB101 Eligibility.

1. In order to compete, all horses must be registered with the American Saddlebred Registry or the Canadian Livestock Records Corporation. They must be entered in their full registered names with registration numbers and under the names of the owner(s) of record with the A.S.R. or the C.L.R.C.

2. A copy of the registration papers showing proof of ownership, or a copy of the registration papers with a Certificate of Eligibility to Show issued by the American Saddlebred Registry must be submitted with entry form at the time of making entry or presented to competition office before competition number will be released; competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement. See GR1309.2a(5). Exception: Horses shown in any USEF Regular Competition prior to December 31, 1979, and Saddlebred-type ponies.

MJMHA MEDAL CLASSES

The MJMHA Medal Classes will be run and judged like the AMHA Medal classes with the exception of that ALL riders will be called to work the selected pattern. The first place winner will receive a Gold Medal, second a Silver, and the third a Bronze. Ribbons will be awarded from fourth place through eighth. Unlike the AMHA Medal Classes, you may continue to compete in the MJMHA Medal Division at remaining shows. Points will accumulate for year-end awards for those MJMHA riders who participate on registered Morgans.

MJMHA CLASSIC HORSE SHOW CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Academy Guidelines

Academy classes are open to riders who actively participate in a bonafide riding lesson program (i.e.: with an instructor who teaches more than one student and accepts payment for such). The rider may not have shown in any division at any show, except 4-H and/or Academy/Tournament shows. Academy horses or ponies must earn their living in a bonafide riding lesson program and may be of any breed. Judging in the Equitation classes will be based on basic equitation skills including correct diagonals, canter leads, balanced form, and effective control of the mount. No test will be allowed, classes will be judged on rail work and in the lineup. Judging in Pleasure classes will be based on showmanship, ring generalship and presentation of the horse to its best ability. The horse or pony will not be judged, however, must display characteristics and manners necessary for safety in a lesson program.

Riders

- Age Classification is determined by USEF Rules.
- Riders who have cantered at any show are not eligible to compete in walk/trot classes.
- Attire to be jodhpur pants and boots with a men's type shirt. A men's necktie should be worn. Vests are permitted. Riding habits are not allowed.
- Protective headgear (SEI approved) is encouraged for all riders. Derbies or other hats are not permitted.
- Hair should be styled neatly back from the face and not obstructing the back number.
- Leather gloves and riding whips/crops are optional.

Horses

- Horses may not be braided. Standard show clipping is permitted.
- Horses may not wear any artificial devices or appointments
- Family owned horses may be used provided the horse is also used for a rider who is not a family member.
- Horses are not required to be shod or plated.
- Horses may be any breed. Stallions are prohibited.
- Horses may be cross entered in other classes; however, performance horses not utilized in a lesson program are prohibited.

Equipment

- An appropriate saddle for the style of riding should be used.
- Any bridle is permissible
- Protective equipment (boots, leg wraps) is permitted.
- Action devices (chains, stretchies, bag whips, noise makers, powder, etc.) are prohibited in the warm-up area and show ring.
